BRANDON BARKUS – HEAD COACH

Brandon Barkus has been the Head Soccer Coach at Augustana since 2006, compiling a record of 127-88-24, four NCAA tournament appearances and one NSIC tournament championship. In 2017, Barkus' club made its fourth NCAA tournament in program history and advanced to the NCAA Second Round for the second time in school history and finished

the season with a record of 14-4-5 (11-1-3 NSIC). The Vikings went on to break the school single season shutout record with 14 shutouts and made its third consecutive NSIC tournament final, finishing as runner-ups for the second straight season. In 2016, for the second consecutive season he guided the Vikings to the NSIC tournament championship, while going 13-5-3 on the season, which is the third best record in program history. Under his tutelage, the Vikings have broken numerous records: North Central Conference wins in a season, school record for wins in a season, and coached numerous student-athletes to All-Conference and All-Region honors. 2015 was the best year in program history with the team going 19-3-1, and winning their first ever conference tournament championship and advancing to the regional championship in the NCAA tournament for the first time in program history. Barkus has his BA in Physical Education from Benedictine College in Atchison, Kansas, and a Master's in Education from Augustana University. Other highlights from Barkus' career include: USSF "A" Coaching License, NSCAA Advanced National Coaching Diploma, USSF National Youth Coaching License, NSCAA Level II Goalkeeping Certificate, Nebraska girls Olympic Development Program Head Coach, USYSA Region 2 Staff Coach, 2007 South Dakota Girls Coach of the Year, 1998 Kansas State Girls Coach of the Year, 3-year starter & All-American Goalkeeper at Benedictine College, Head Coach at Baker University in Kansas, Director of Coaching at Olathe Soccer Club in Olathe, KS.



ARIC SPADER – ASSISTANT COACH

Aric Spader was a Soccer Graduate Assistant from 2015-16 and was elevated to Assistant Coach in 2017. With Spader's assistance in 2017, Augustana made its fourth NCAA tournament in program history and advanced to the NCAA Second Round for the second time in school history, finishing the season with a record of 14-4-5 (11-1-3 NSIC). The

Vikings went on to break the school single season shutout record with 14 shutouts and made its third consecutive NSIC tournament final, finishing as runner-ups for the second straight season. In 2016 Spader helped the Vikings to a record of 13-5-3 (10-2-3 NSIC) finishing fourth in the NSIC standings and concluding their season in the NSIC Tournament title match. In 2015 he helped guide the team to their first ever NSIC Tournament championship when they defeated Winona State 1-0. The NSIC tournament victory also clinched the programs third ever NCAA Tournament Berth. In the 2015 NCAA tournament the Vikings won their first ever NCAA tournament match by defeating Harding University 2-1. Spader played four years of high school soccer at Washington High School, and six years of club soccer for Dakota Gold. He played collegiately at Mount Marty College, where his career was cut short due to injury. In 2014, Spader was an assistant at Roosevelt High School, helping guide the girls' soccer team to a 9-2-1 record, qualifying for postseason play. Spader currently holds a USSF National "C" License.

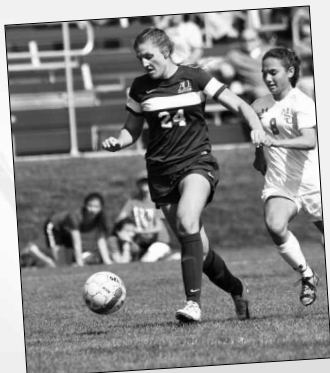
