CAMP DIRECTORS



BRANDON BARKUS – HEAD COACH

has been the head soccer coach at Augustana since 2006, compiling a record of 155-99-28, six NCAA tournament appearances and one NSIC tournament championship. In 2019, Barkus's squad won 16 games (the second-most in program history), advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the third time in school history, went to the NCAA

Tournament for the third year in a row and fifth in the last six years and went 12-2-1 in NSIC play. The Vikings defeated Central Oklahoma 2-1 in the first round of the NCAA Tournament on Nov. 22 before falling in the next round. Barkus saw seven of his players earn All-NSIC honors (including three on the All-NSIC First Team), three earn USCA All-Region honors, two earn D2CCA All-Region honors, one earn CoSIDA Academic All-District honors, one earn NSIC All-tournament honors. 2018 proved to be another banner year, advancing to the programs fourth NCAA tournament in the last five seasons. Barkus not only led the Vikings to their sixth consecutive double-digit win total, but also racked up 12 NSIC wins. For the first time in program history, Barkus also saw one of his student-athletes earn All-America honors as Rebekah Thoresen was named 2018 D2CCA All-American second team. Under his tutelage, the Vikings have broken numerous records: NCC and NSIC wins in a season, school record for wins in a season, and coached numerous student-athletes to All-Conference, All-Region, and All-American honors. Barkus has his BA in Physical Education from Benedictine College in Atchison, KS, and a Master's in Education from Augustana University. Barkus has completed his USSF "A" Coaching License, NSCAA Advanced National Coaching Diploma, USSF National Youth Coaching License, NSCAA Level II Goalkeeping Certificate. He has been a part of Nebraska ODP, USYSA Region 2 Staff Coach. In 1998 he was the Kansas State Girls Coach of the Year, and in 2007 and 2019 was the South Dakota Girls Coach of the Year. He was a three year starter and All American GK at Benedictine College. Barkus began his coaching career at Baker University in Kansas, and spent time as the Director of Coaching at Olathe Soccer Club in Olathe, KS.



ARIC SPADER – ASSISTANT COACH

Aric Spader was a soccer graduate assistant from 2015-2016 and was elevated to assistant coach in 2017. The Vikings have made it to the NCAA Tournament in each of Spader's seasons as a full-time assistant coach. In 2019 the Vikings went 16-5-1 and won the second-most games in program history. They went to the NSIC Tournament for the seventh-

consecutive season, NCAA Tournament for the third consecutive season and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the third time in school history. In his second full season as an assistant coach, Spader helped guide the 2018 Vikings to a 12-6-3 record and NCAA Tournament appearance for the second year in a row, fifth time in school history and fourth time in the last five years. With Spader's assistance in 2017, Augustana made its fourth NCAA tournament in program history and advanced to the NCAA Second Round for the second time in school history, finishing the season with a record of 14-4-5 (11-1-3 NSIC). The Vikings went on to break the school single season shutout record with 14 shutouts and made its third consecutive NSIC tournament final, finishing as runner-ups for the second straight season. Spader played at Washington High School, and club soccer for Dakota Gold. He played briefly at Mount Marty College, where his career was cut short due to injury. He has his BS in Psychology from South Dakota State University, and Master's in Sports Administration and Leadership from Augustana University. He was named the 2017 South Dakota Girls Coach of the Year and holds a USSF "C" License.

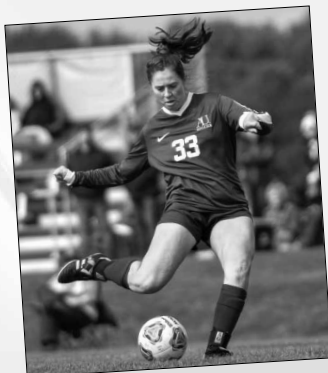
